LA COUNTY RENT REGISTRY

The Los Angeles County Rent Stabilization and Tenant Protections Ordinance (RSTPO) is a local law that limits annual rent increases (rent-stabilized units only) based on changes in the Consumer Price Index and provides tenants protections from evictions without just cause for residential rental units in the unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County.

On or before September 30th of each year, an owner must register each unit, unless fully exempt, that is rented or is available for rent in the County's Rent Registry system or on a form approved by the Los Angeles County Department of Consumer and Business Affairs (DCBA).

NOTICE: EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2024

The Los Angeles County Development Authority (LACDA) will begin monitoring the Los Angeles County RSTPO requirements that owners must adhere to when requesting a rent increase and/or terminating a tenancy. It is imperative that owners and the LACDA's rental assistance programs adhere to local ordinances, especially when they are designed to promote long-term stability and security for tenants in the rental market while providing owners a fair and reasonable return on their property.

Property owners and tenants may access the Los Angeles County Rent Registry system to register and/or verify coverage under the Los Angeles County RSTPO by visiting www.rentregistry.dcba.lacounty.gov.
